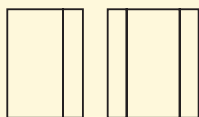

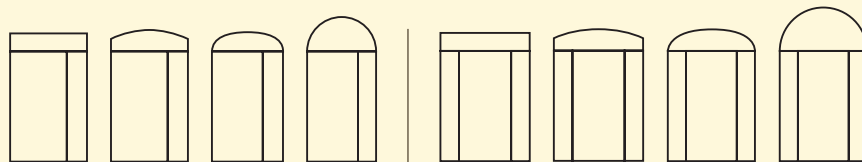

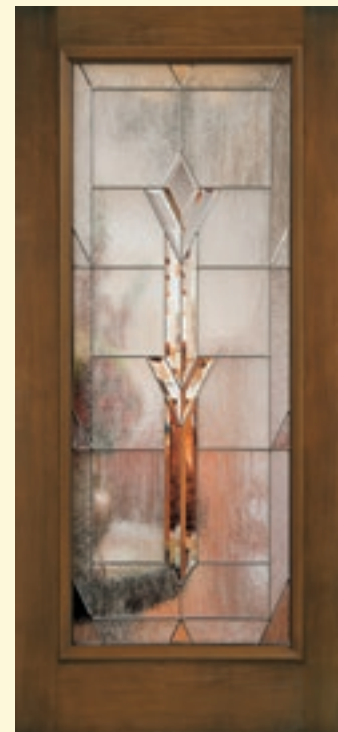

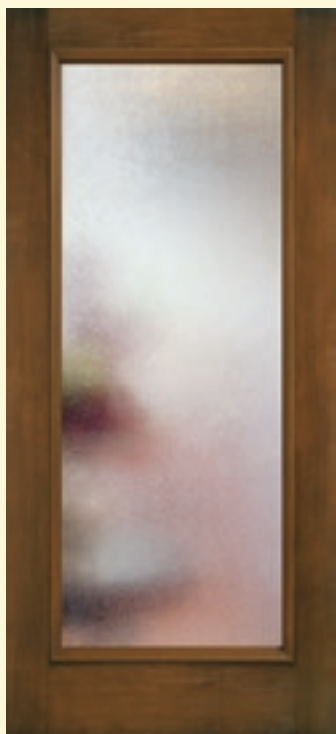
Decorative Glass

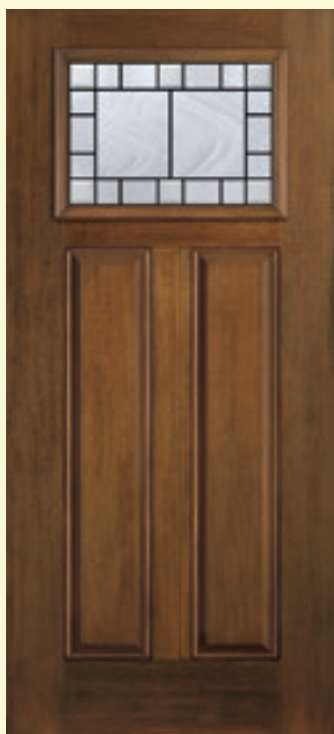


Obscure Low-E Glass
